

Pot busts got a lot higher in '10

MORE New Yorkers are getting busted for possession of marijuana, according to a new report released yesterday.

The NYPD arrested 50,383 people for carrying pot in 2010 — about 15% of all arrests for the year, according to the New York Division of Criminal Justice Services.

About 70% of last year's arrests were people younger than 30. Al-

most 86% were black or Latino, the data shows.

According to the same report, there were 29,752 arrests in 2005 — 41% fewer than last year.

“New York has made more marijuana arrests under [Mayor Michael] Bloomberg than any mayor in New York City history,” said Dr. Harry Levine, a sociology professor at Queens College.
